Enhancements

Navigation

• When users with **New** or **Edit** security privileges click to expand the navigation menu, they can now click **Collaboration Portal** to open the Frontline Collaboration Portal in a new tab. (*SpecialServices Classic User Guide, SpecialServices Classic System Manager Guide*)

System Configuration

• The new Enable Collaboration Portal checkbox lets administrators enable or disable the Collaboration Portal menu item. (SpecialServices Classic System Manager Guide)

View Completed Tasks

• The loading time for PDFs of completed tasks has been improved.

Special Education Import (SpS)

 (E14940) When you import files with records that contain matching **Disability Condition** and **Section 504 Plan** values that already exist on the corresponding student FD record and have a later IEP or ETR date than the **Effective Date** on the FD record, you no longer receive the error message "Error! Record has same disability condition and section 504 plan but different effective date as an existing record." The matching record in the import file is not imported.

Resolved Issue

Security

- (D15474) Previously, when an ITC disabled the TLS 1.0 or 1.1 security protocol on their server(s), an error occurred in the following circumstances:
 - When you attempted to access SpecialServices Classic before you logged in to ProgressBook
 - When you attempted to generate a PDF for printing
 - When you attempted to complete a task

Now, when the TLS 1.0 or 1.1 security protocol is disabled, SpecialServices Classic functions as expected in these circumstances.



GradeBook Class Dashboard

Previously, when you clicked beside a student's name in the class roster to access the student's special education forms, a blank screen sometimes displayed instead of the Task Queue screen or the Completed Tasks screen (depending on your security privileges) in SpecialServices Classic. Now, in this circumstance, the Task Queue screen or the Completed Tasks screen displays successfully.

• You can now select the **Enable Data Extracts** checkbox so that nightly extracts for the following data are created for import into Frontline Service and Plan Management: Transportation, Service Lines, Plan, Goals, Medicaid Parental Consent, and Objectives.

Note: This setting should be enabled only if your district plans to transition to Frontline Service and Plan Management.
